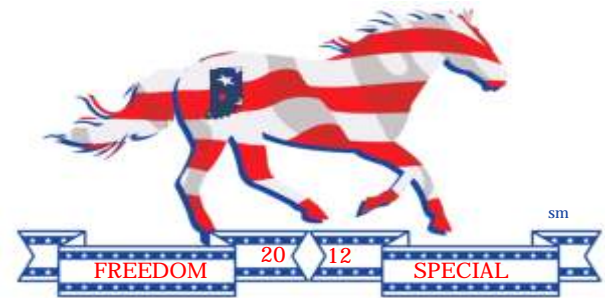

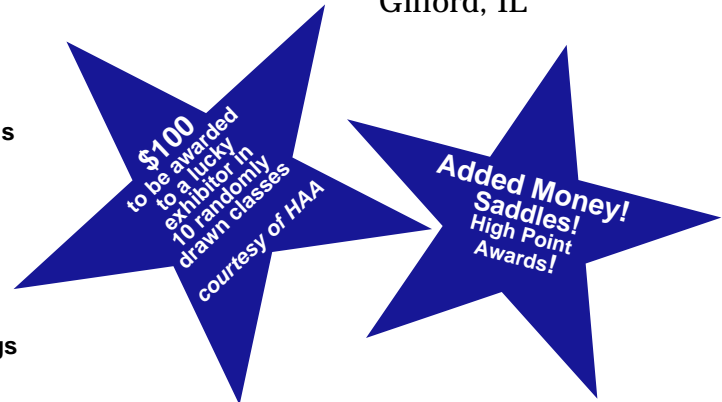

Youth Entry: \$5 per entry/judge plus \$1 ApHC fee per judge
Non-Pro Entry: \$7 per entry/judge plus \$1 ApHC fee per judge
Open Entry: \$9 per entry/judge plus \$2 ApHC fee per judge
**AGHA Classes: \$7 per class (1 set pts.)
Trailer-In Fee: \$15 per day

Cattle Charge: \$15 per run. Working Cow Horse will be done on Roping Steers. There may be working cow horse cattle available by showtime, call ahead if this is an issue.

Stalls: \$90. A \$10 discount will apply if stalls are PREPAID no later than March 23, 2012, making the stall charge \$80 each. For stall reservation info contact Carol Taufmann at (765) 663-2218, or email at taufmannca@aol.com. No refunds on stalls after March 23, 2012, without a vet Certificate – NO EXCEPTIONS!

Youth & Non Pro Optional Blanket Fee: \$135 Unlimited Youth & Non Pro Classes plus \$1 ApHC fee per judge. TO QUALIFY FOR YOUTH & NON-PRO OPTIONAL BLANKET FEE, EXHIBITORS MUST SHOW IN AN OPEN HALTER CLASS. (Blanket fee will cover one rider/unlimited horses. Youth & Non-Pro utilizing the blanket may cross over into open classes by paying only the \$2 per judge per class ApHC fee.

Bedding: Available for purchase on the grounds or bring your own (wood shavings only).

Camping hookups: \$20/night - First come first served.

NOTE: All owners & exhibitors must have current ApHC National Membership cards in the appropriate divisions.

*** Please Read! ***

Illinois State law requires a current negative Coggins (EIA) test within 12 months to date of show. Illinois entry requirements for out-of-state equines – All Equines entering Illinois for any reason other than slaughter just be accompanied by a negative test for EIA conducted within a year if the animal is more than one year of age, certificate of veterinary inspection issued by an accredited vet within 30 days of entry, and an entry permit issued by the Illinois Department of Agriculture. Entry permits are available by calling the IL DofA, 217.782.4944, and are issued 24 hours a day, seven days a week. There is no charge for obtaining an entry permit from the IL DofA. Permit numbers are also available online at www.agr.state.il.us.

How to Get to Gordyville

From Indiana: take I-74 to the Ogden, IL exit. Go north approx. 9 miles to Penfield. Turn left (West) on 136 (Oasis Bar & Grill on your right) and go approx. 4 miles.

From north or south: take I-57 to the Rantoul exit. Go East approx. 7 miles. There are three hotels close to this exit (Best Western, Days Inn and Super 8).

From the west: go east on 136 through Rantoul.
